**Report of the
Extraordinary delegate assembly of the
ELTE TTK DÖK Delegate Assembly
held on August 28, 2026 at 9:00 AM**

Botond G. Gereczi states that the delegate assembly has a quorum pursuant to Section 7(2) of Annex 3 to the „EDÖK Alapszabály”.

Botond G. Gereczi opened the meeting.

Botond G. Gereczi assumes the responsibility of keeping the minutes of the meeting.

The Delegate Assembly elected András Gombás with 3 yes votes and appointed Levente Szemerédi as members of the Vote Counting Committee.

Botond Géza Gereczi presented the previously sent agenda items.

The Delegate Assembly adopted the agenda of the meeting with 3 yes votes.

Delegate Election

Botond Géza Gereczi explained that Dániel Jánosi (delegate to the Council of the Institute of Physics and Astronomy) and Péter Kosztyó (delegate to the Council of the Doctoral School of Physics) can no longer perform their delegation duties due to obtaining their absolutions, which is why they resigned from their mandate in writing. Both of our delegates proposed Zoltán Kovács to continue fulfilling their mandates, who indicated that if elected, he would assume the representative duties.

Since no further nominations were received, Botond G. Gereczi submitted the delegation of Zoltán Kovács to the Council of the Doctoral School of Physics and the Council of the Institute of Physics and Astronomy for a secret ballot.

The Delegate Assembly elected Zoltán Kovács as the delegate of the Council of the Doctoral School of Physics with 3 yes votes by secret ballot.

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Others

Botond G. Gereczi asked András Gombás if there was any news about the Nyugdíj Matching Fund (2026-3.1.3-MF) application, whether ELTE planned to apply? András Gombás promised to follow up.

András Gombás explained the situation surrounding the DRC. Fortunately, the problem now seems to be resolved.

Botond G. Gereczi announced that he will take the initiative to investigate the legal basis for the tight deadlines related to the doctoral degree acquisition procedure and will take the initiative to allow flexibility in the tight deadlines by citing a force majeure situation.

András Gombás drew attention to the tasks related to the upcoming parliamentary elections.

Botond G. Gereczi closed the meeting.
