Botond Géza Gereczi states that the meeting has a quorum with 5 members

Botond Géza Gereczi opened the meeting.

Botond Géza Gereczi will take the minutes of the meeting

The Delegate Assembly elected András Gombás with 4 yes votes and 1 abstention and appointed Levente Szemerédi as members of the Vote Counting Committee.

Botond Géza Gereczi presented the previously sent agenda items and initiated the filling of the currently vacant delegate seat in the EDÖK Delegate Assembly due to the election of András Gombás as president.

The Delegate Assembly adopted the agenda of the meeting with the above amendment with 4 yes votes and 1 abstention.

1. DÖK participation in the TTK Doctoral Student Open Day *(For details, see the attached document)*

The Doctoral Student Self-Government previously took an active role in the TTK Doctoral Student Open Day on May 4, 2026.

Botond Géza Gereczi explained that the preliminary program is available on the website <https://ttk.elte.hu/doktori2026>.

Botond Géza Gereczi explained which doctoral student(s) from each doctoral school took part in the event.

In response to a question from András Gombás, Botond Géza Gereczi explained the preliminary program in detail.

András Gombás and Levente Szemerédi initiated a minor modification of the preliminary program.

Botond Géza Gereczi promised to contact the heads of the doctoral schools in this regard.

Botond Géza Gereczi explained what tasks the “invited” doctoral students might have.

András Gombás and Levente Szemerédi make suggestions about the tasks.

The Delegates’ Assembly will develop its final position and strategy for the TTK Doctoral Student Open Day. In this context, András Gombás and Botond Géza Gereczi briefly explained that the TTK DÖK had ordered catering for the event.

2. Voting on filling the EDÖK Delegate Assembly seat

Botond Géza Gereczi explained that due to the election of András Gombás as EDÖK president, a mandate has become available for the TTK DÖK, so there is an opportunity to delegate a new member.

Based on a public call, Emmanuel Owusu-Achempong is nominated for the task, who accepts the nomination and briefly presents his ideas.

Levente Szemerédi asks a question to the candidate.

Dániel Jánosi left the meeting.

The Delegate Assembly unanimously approved by secret ballot, with 5 yes votes, No. 1/2026 (IV. 27.). resolution on the delegation of Emmanuel Owusu-Achempong to the Delegate Assembly of the University Doctoral Student Self-Government.

3. Presidential report

Botond Géza Gereczi briefly reported on the most important events of his presidential term so far, emphasizing that all details can be read in his monthly reports.

The Delegate Assembly unanimously adopted resolution No. 2/2026 (IV. 27.) by secret ballot, with 5 yes votes, regarding the presidential report of Botond Géza Gereczi.

4. Other

András Gombás asked Botond Géza Gereczi what his plans were for the remainder of his presidential term.

In response to the question, Botond Géza Gereczi explained that he would like to continue to keep issues related to the possibilities of the operating regulations of doctoral schools on the agenda, he will try to encourage doctoral students to apply for the local government during the elections, and he will be there in all his representative offices to ensure that decisions are made in accordance with the interests of doctoral students.

András Gombás suggested that Botond Géza Gereczi also deal with the development of the detailed rules of the new type of Cooperative Doctoral Training, so that it runs more smoothly than the current one.

Botond Géza Gereczi expressed his agreement with the proposal.

Botond Géza Gereczi closed the meeting.
